

Support to Achieve QI QoF Domain

Quality improvement is a new domain within the 2019/20 General Medical Services (GMS) contract Quality & Outcomes Framework (QOF) in Prescribing Safety & End of Life Care. Being skilled in Quality Improvement has been recognised as a key role for healthcare professionals (CQC March 2018).

What can AQuA do?

As part of your AQuA CCG membership for 2019/20 we can provide free support for you to:

- Recognise areas of care which require improvement (QI001 and QI003)
- Address these through QI methodologies (QI001 and QI003)
- Plan & share learning across your network (QI002 and QI004)
- Participate in QI activities through diagnostics, planning & networking

How will we do this?

To achieve these 74 QoF points, AQuA can facilitate a series of tailored 3 x 2 hour WebExs with individual coaching to help you:

Web Ex 1

- Evaluate current quality of care using baseline auditing and evaluation.
- Identify QI activities & improvement goals required for the areas identified
- Learn to work as a supportive network by sharing ideas, progress and solutions
- Map your practice workflow including community and secondary care services

Web Ex 2

- Develop your improvement plan through reliable QI activities
- Develop a measurement plan to assess progress
- Learn to identify and recruit a patient, family or carer as part of your the QI team
- Develop a QI implementation plan

Web Ex 3

- Share learning and results across practices & PCNs
- Evidence that you have been involved in network peer review meetings
- Develop shared working preferences and behaviours to achieve QI goals
- Learn about sustainability, spread and evaluation
- Promote your improvement through articles, posters, patient information resources, linking to national bodies

In addition, there are opportunities for one to one telephone QI coaching advice if more appropriate.
